Carolina Gas Transmission (CGT), a SCANA company is helping to meet our region's need for a clean, safe and secure source of energy throughout the Southeast. Established in 2006 with the merger of two former SCANA subsidiaries, South Carolina Pipeline Corporation and SCG Pipeline, Inc., CGT is an interstate natural gas transportation company that delivers natural gas to distribution systems and direct industrial customers.

CAPACITY

Through its pipeline system of approximately 1,500 miles, CGT delivers value to customers. CGT's pipeline provides the critical infrastructure link between end users and wholesale supply access. Customers contract with CGT to ensure that pipeline capacity is available to transport their natural gas supply whenever it is needed, 365 days per year. The CGT team takes this obligation seriously and operates our pipeline system to ensure we are prepared to meet our firm obligations each day. This reliability of capacity allows end users to focus on their business and not worry about pipeline capacity.

RELIABILITY

CGT provides safe and reliable service to local distribution companies, municipalities, power generators and industries throughout South Carolina and a portion of Georgia. Safety and reliability are our highest priorities as we operate our pipeline in an environmentally responsible manner. We have a well-trained and committed work force that is focused on operating and maintaining our pipeline system in a manner that meets or exceeds all applicable regulations required by various federal, state and local entities. As a member of the 160-year-old SCANA family, CGT provides safe and reliable service that customers have come to know and expect from all of SCANA's companies. CGT is also committed to protecting the natural beauty and historic heritage that makes South Carolina and its surrounding regions a special place to live and work.



SUPPLY DIVERSITY

Access to wholesale gas supply is another key way that CGT delivers value to customers. In today's natural gas marketplace, customers using large volumes of gas often want more control and flexibility in managing purchasing strategies. CGT provides its customers access to diverse supply sources through its pipeline interconnections with Transcontinental Gas Pipeline, a six-BCF-per-day pipeline, and Southern Natural Gas, a three-BCF-per-day pipeline. Additionally, CGT is connected to a growing source of regional supply via its connection with the Southern LNG Importation Terminal located at Elba Island near Savannah, Georgia. The Elba Island facility has announced expansion plans that will increase the daily supply output to more than two BCF as early as 2013. CGT is uniquely positioned to enhance value for current and future customers with access to these three major supply sources, providing customers with flexibility in both supply and deliverability.

The natural gas supply picture continues to evolve with the addition of shale gas providing nonconventional supply sources in new geographic areas. The hub-like nature of CGT positions its customers to take advantage of these changing supply conditions to negotiate the best supply arrangement to meet their specific natural gas needs.



INFORMATION

CGT provides timely information through its Electronic Bulletin Board (EBB). Here customers may access scheduled quantities, measurement data, invoices, operational notices, and a variety of reports to help manage their natural gas usage. CGT is committed to excellence in customer service and strives to meet with customers regularly to share information and identify customer needs. Each customer has a dedicated account manager committed to ensuring its unique expectations are understood and met. CGT strives to provide meaningful information to its customers through a series of meetings with small groups of customers throughout the year as well as our annual Shipper Meeting. We frequently include outside speakers who have information or insight that could be valuable to our customers. To ensure information is available for all customers, CGT regularly posts the presentation material from such meetings on its EBB.
