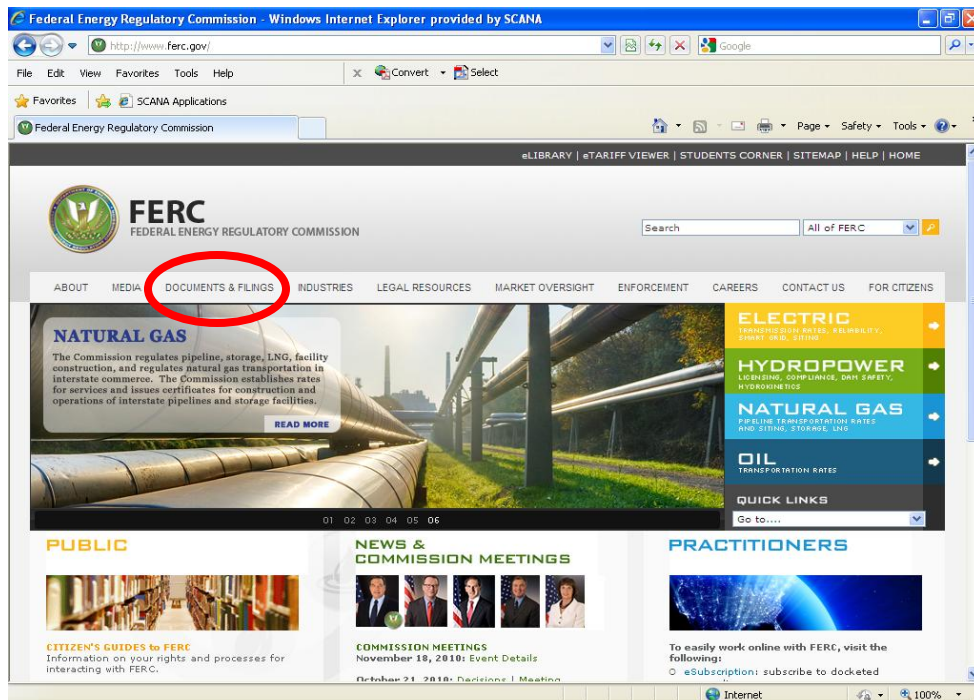
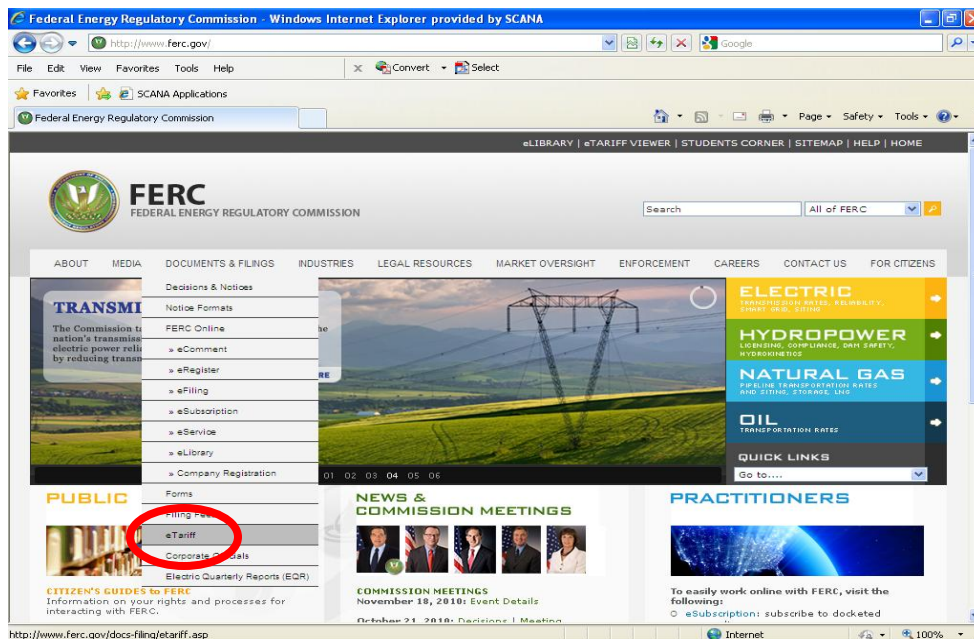


# Finding Carolina Gas Transmission's Tariff on the FERC Website

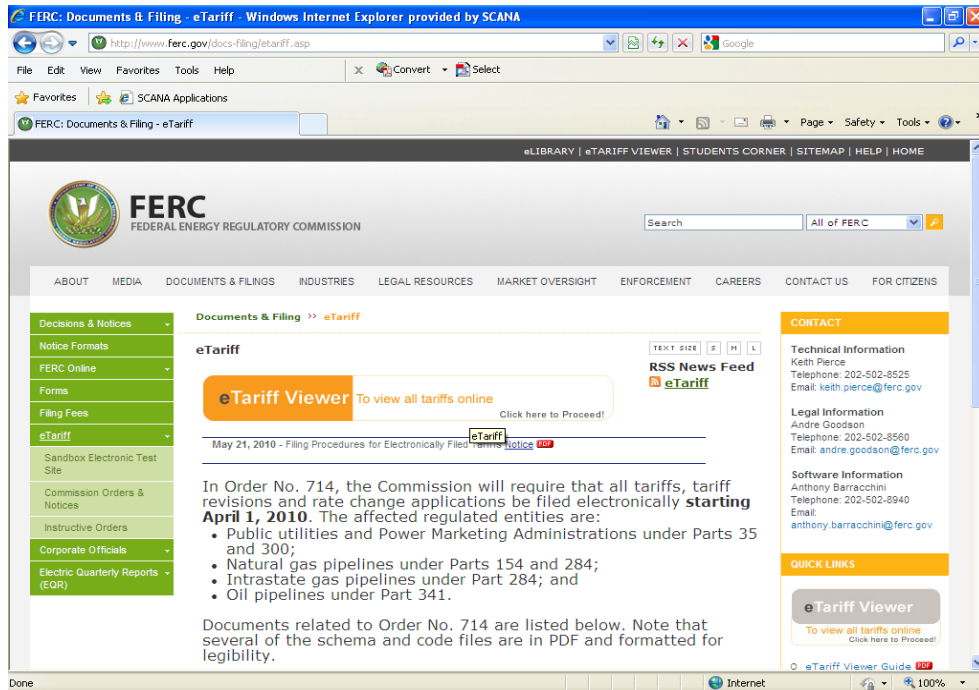
In the web browser type: [www.FERC.Gov](http://www.FERC.Gov)



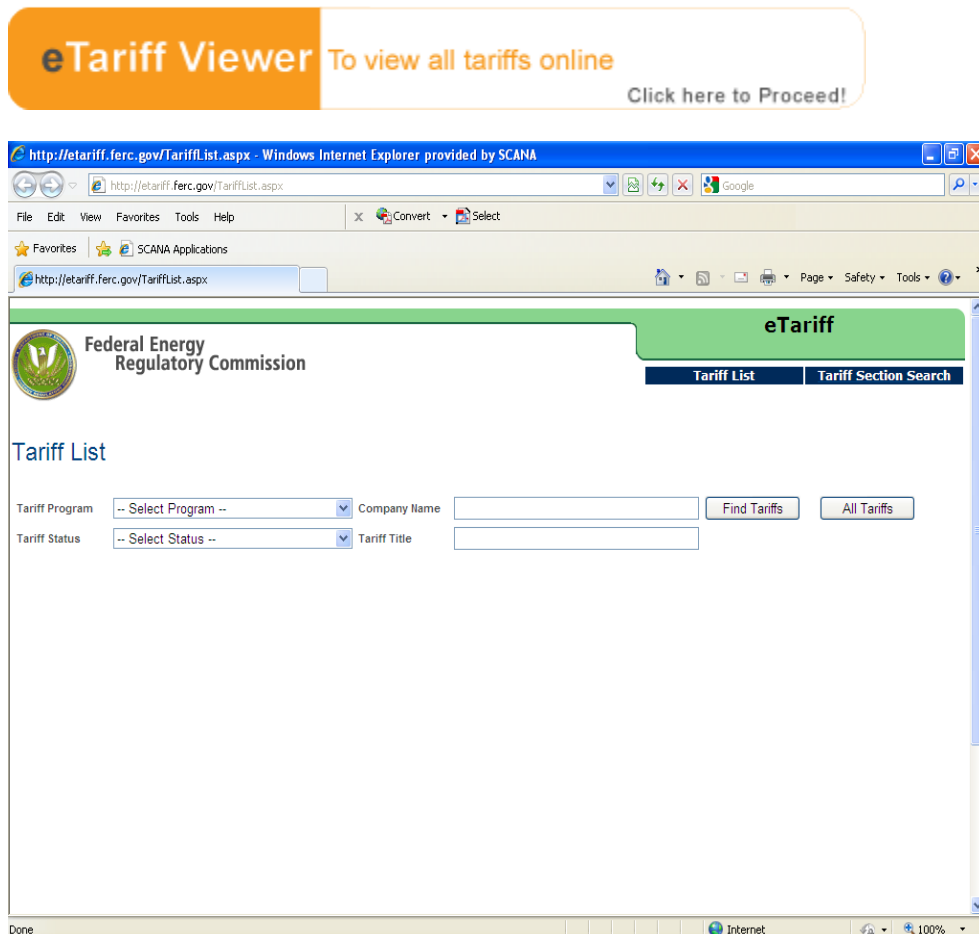
Under "Documents & Filings", select "eTariff".



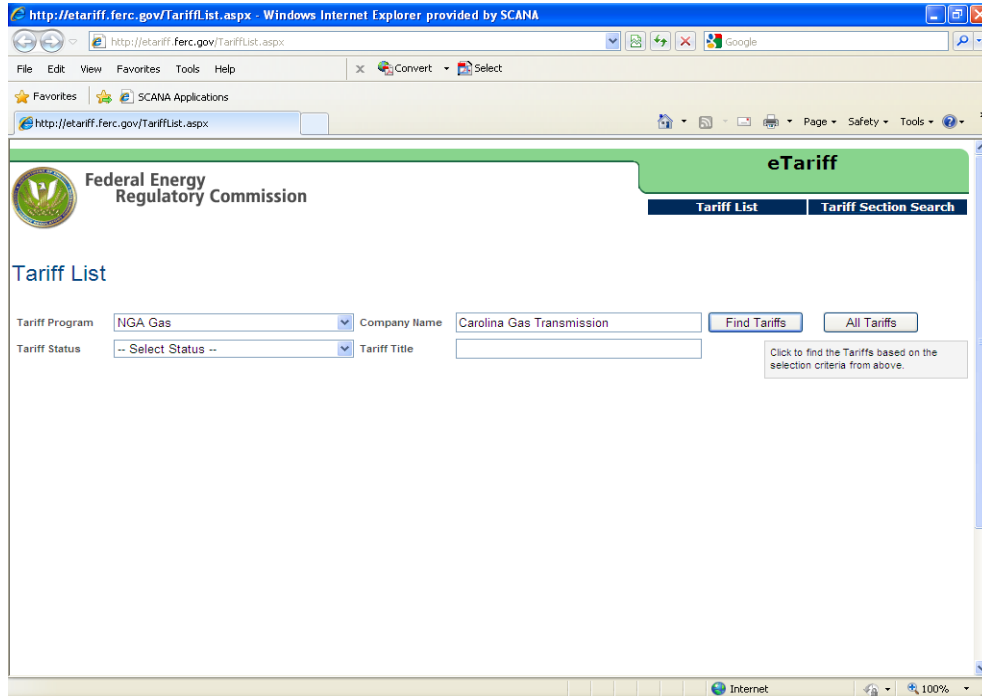
This will bring up the eTariff page.



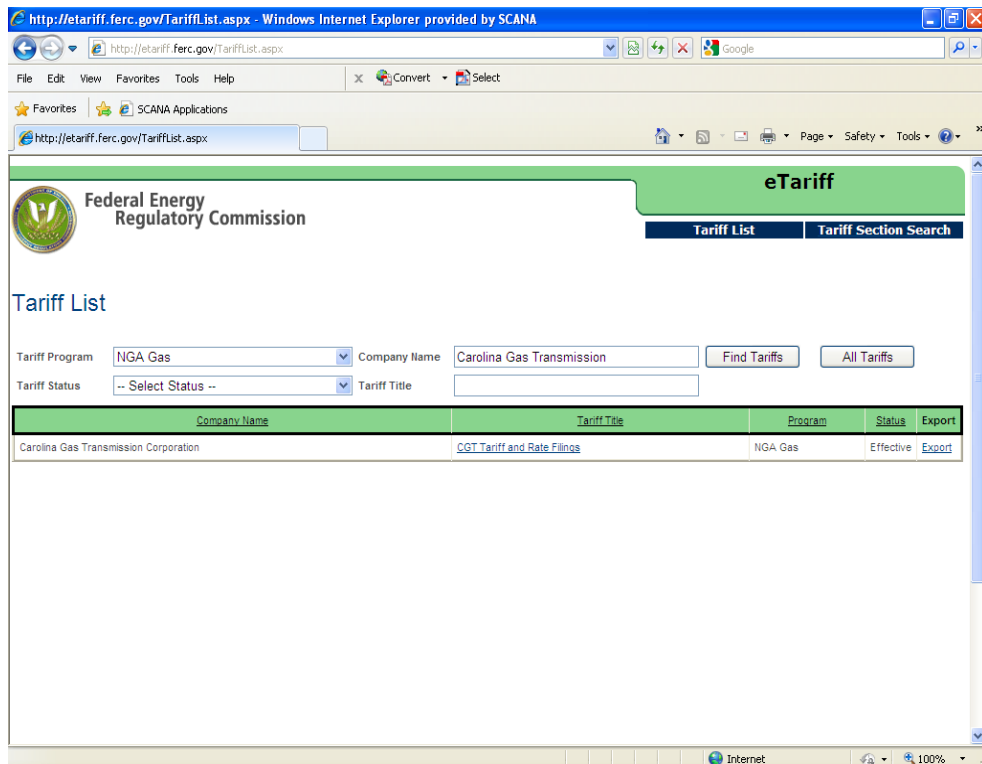
On this page, select the following link which will bring up the eTariff search page.

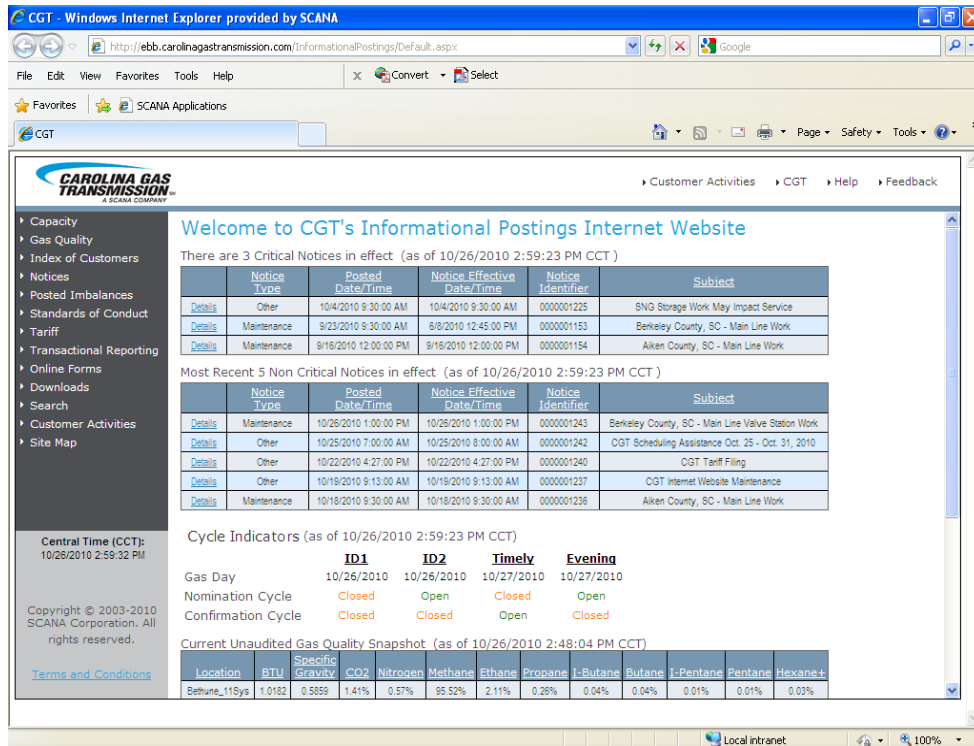
